

English

In English our work will be based upon fairy stories and traditional tales. Our key texts will include, The Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood, and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Our writing will involve sequencing and retelling the story.

We will continue to strengthen our reading using the 'Letters and Sounds' scheme, as well as learn the year 1 common exception words.

We will keep working on our handwriting as well as including finger-spaces, full stops and capital letters in our sentences. We will continue to learn how to use the co-ordinating conjunctions 'and' and 'but' in our writing, as well as question-marks. We will also be introduced to some more suffix endings, for example -ed and -ing.

Computing

We will continue to practise keyboard skills and learn how to create pictures using different computer programs, such as Microsoft Paint.

Art & Design and Design & technology

This term we will look at different types of materials and make creations linked to our fairy tales.

Science


In Science we will recap everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

Personal and social Development

Geometry

- Recognise 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- Recognise irregular shapes.

Addition and subtraction

- Add and subtract numbers using a number line.
- Solve problems using objects and pictures.
- Number bonds to 10 and 20.
- Add and subtract in jumps of 10 and 1.

Time

- Sequence events in chronological order.
- Recognise and use language relating to dates, including days of the week, weeks, months and years.

P.E.

Our learning in P.E. will continue to focus on multi-skills activities, team games and basic dance skills.

Geography Focus

In Geography we will recap the four countries of the United Kingdom, their location and the names of the capital cities.

We will continue to use maps, atlases and globes to investigate the World's 7 continents and 5 oceans.

What can you do to help?

Recap addition and subtraction using objects and/or a number line. Challenge your child to doing some simple addition and subtraction using their mental methods.

Discuss the different types of materials used around us. What materials could you find at home with your child, in the park, on the beach? Please take photos or bring things in to show us.

Look out for different shapes used on a variety of objects at home or when out and about. What 2D and 3D shapes can you find with your child?

Please also continue to read every week with your child as it really helps them develop their phonic knowledge and confidence. We'd love them to read at home at least three times each week.
