

Maths

We are consolidating and revisiting previous topics including place value where Year 3 children will learn about numbers up to 1000 and Year 4 children will learn numbers up to 10,000.

We will also learn about shapes and their properties, including area and perimeter.

Computing

We will develop our basic computer skills such as saving our work correctly and continue to work on coding.

Art/Design and Technology

Linked to our European Neighbours topic, we will be learning about foods from the Mediterranean and designing, creating and tasting some of our own!

English

Our books for this half term are 'The Pebble in my Pocket' and 'Guess Who's Coming for Dinner?'

We will be researching, drafting, perfecting and presenting different forms of writing and ensuring that it includes all of the features that we have covered this year. This will work alongside weekly spelling lessons and reading activities.

Geography

We learning about the human geography of European countries, such as trade and the distribution of natural resources. Within this topic, we will also learn about 'Brexit' and the benefits and disadvantages of being part of the EU.

PE

The children will be practising, evaluating and improving their balls skills. We shall have a focus on wall games where the children will understand simple principles and tactics and use them effectively in a game activity. As well as to adapt, make and keep to rules for net games.

Science

We will learning about forces and magnets by observing, predicting and comparing what they do. We will look at how things move on different surfaces, identify some magnetic materials and describe whether two magnets will attract or repel each other.

We will also learn about States of Matter, which includes finding out about solids, liquids and gases.

Music

We will be playing and performing using voice and instruments as well as using French language in our singing.
