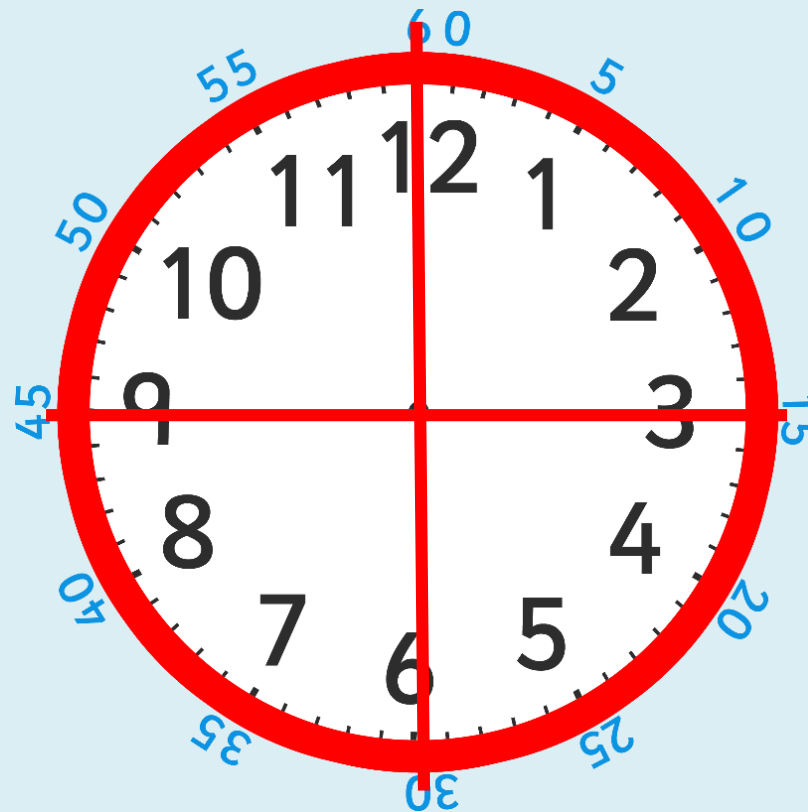
How many minutes are there in **half an hour**?

How many days are there in **a year**?

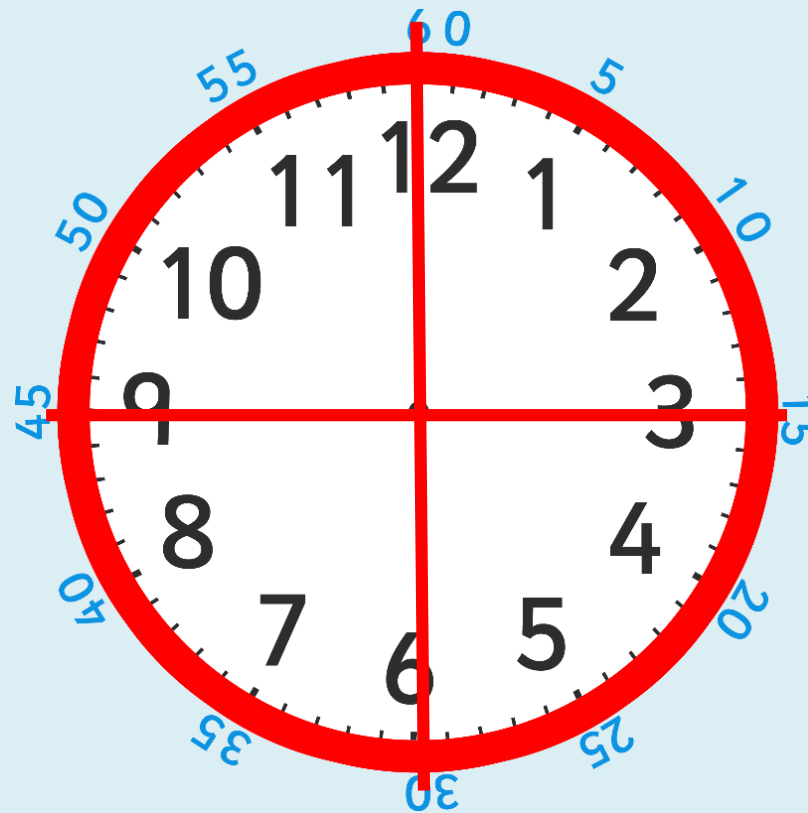
How many days are there in **a leap year**?

A clock face is a full circle which is made up of 4 quarters.

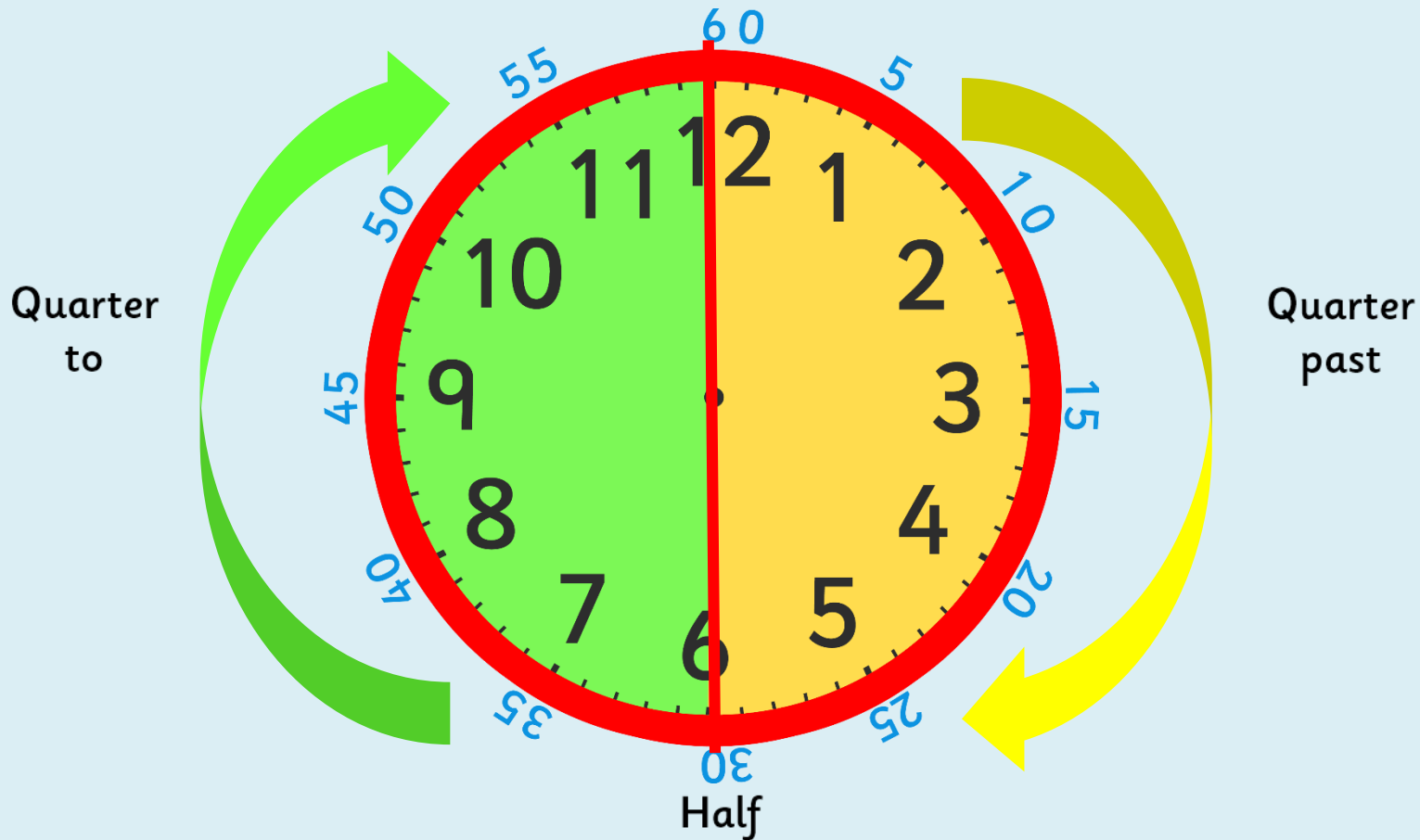


How many minutes make up quarter of an hour?

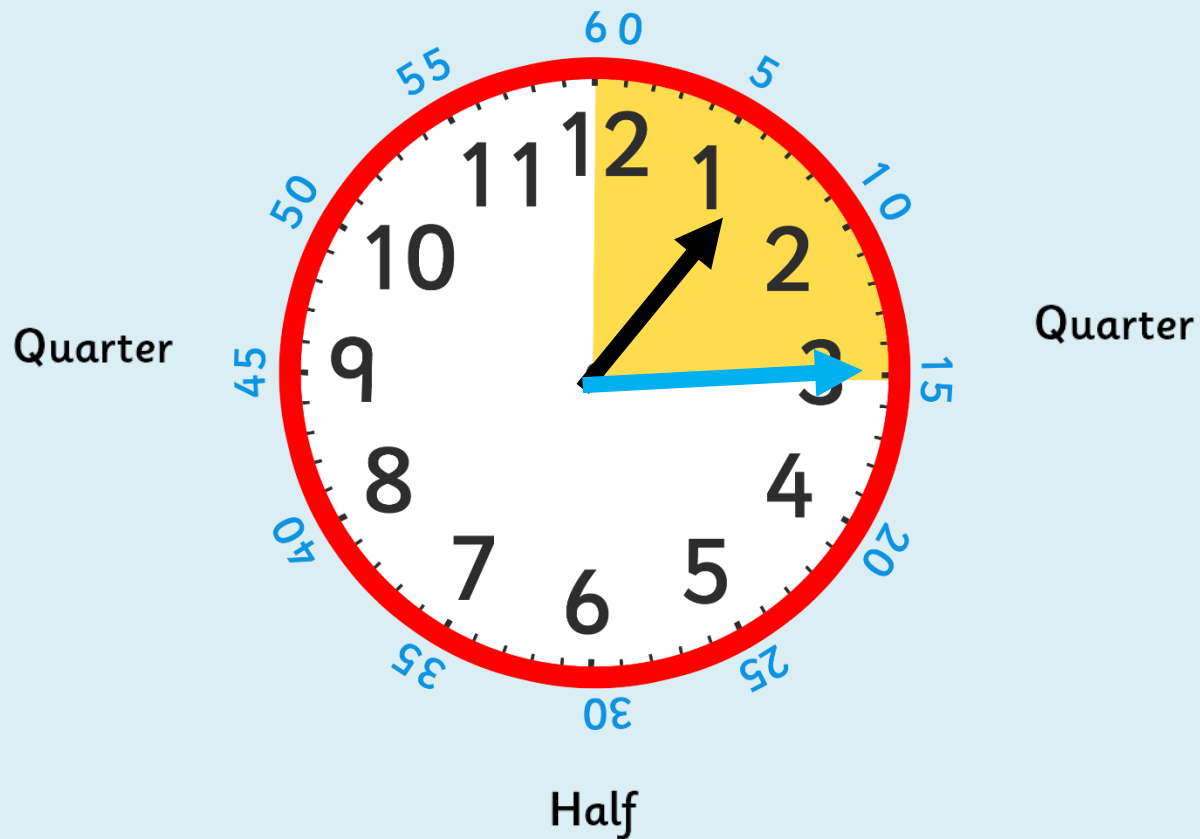
There are **15 minutes** in quarter of an hour.



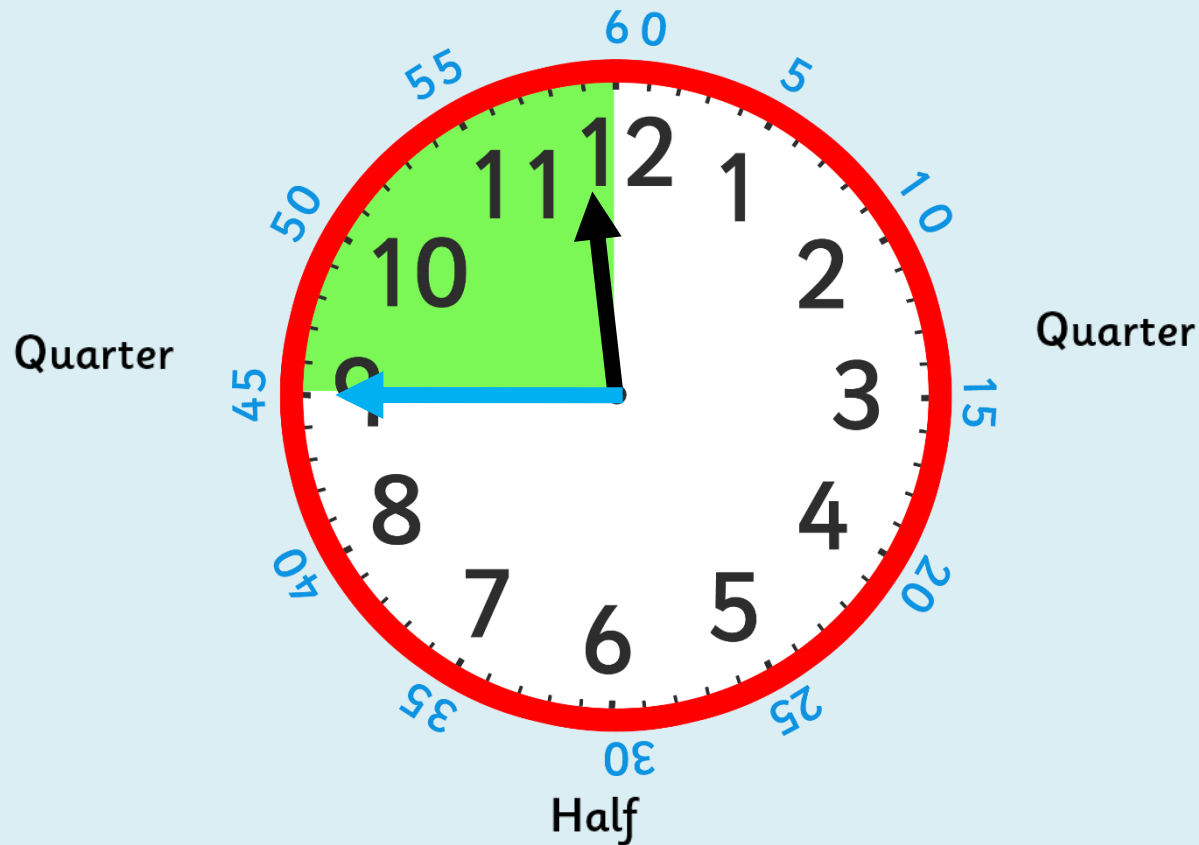
When we tell the time we either say it is 'past' or 'to' the hour.
This clock below helps show that.



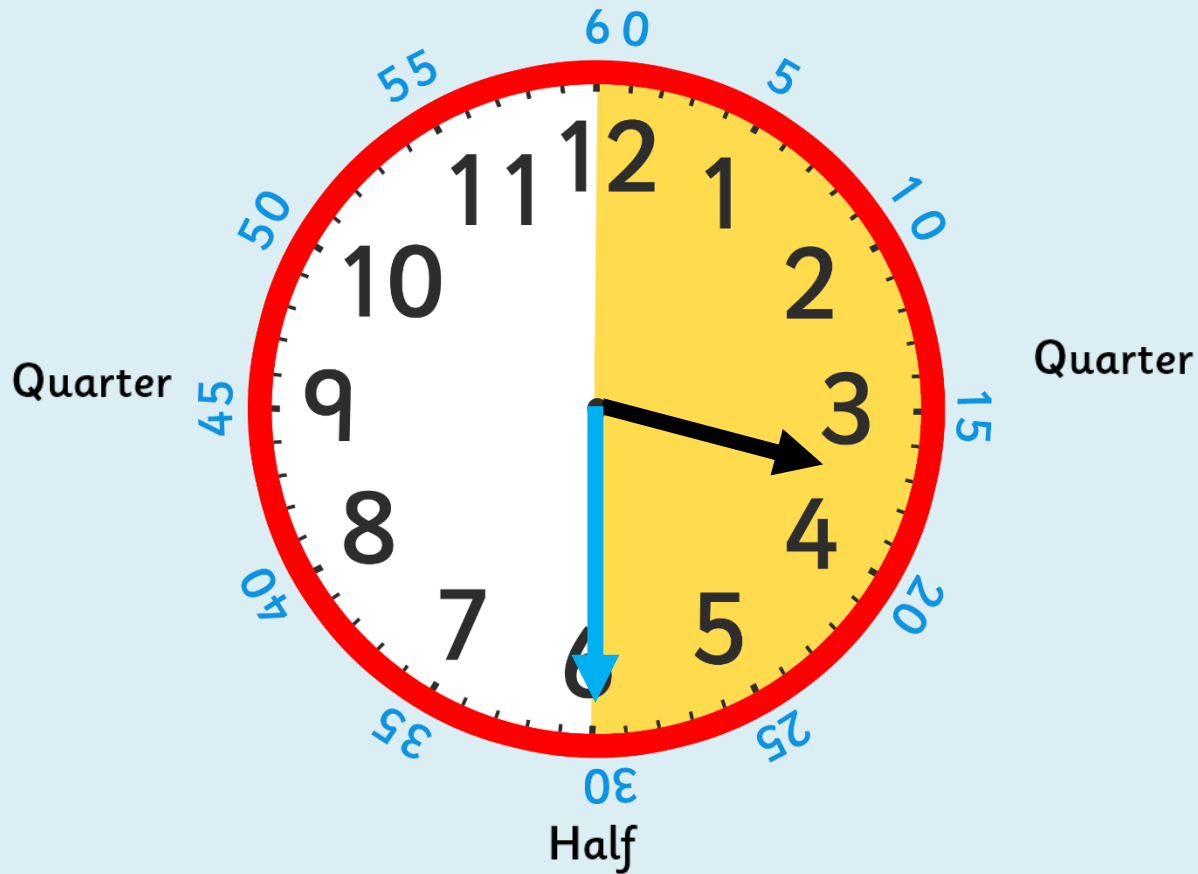
This clock is showing quarter past 1.
The big hand is pointing at 3, which is the first quarter.
Can you see that the little hand isn't pointing straight at 1? It's actually a quarter of the way between 1 and 2.
