

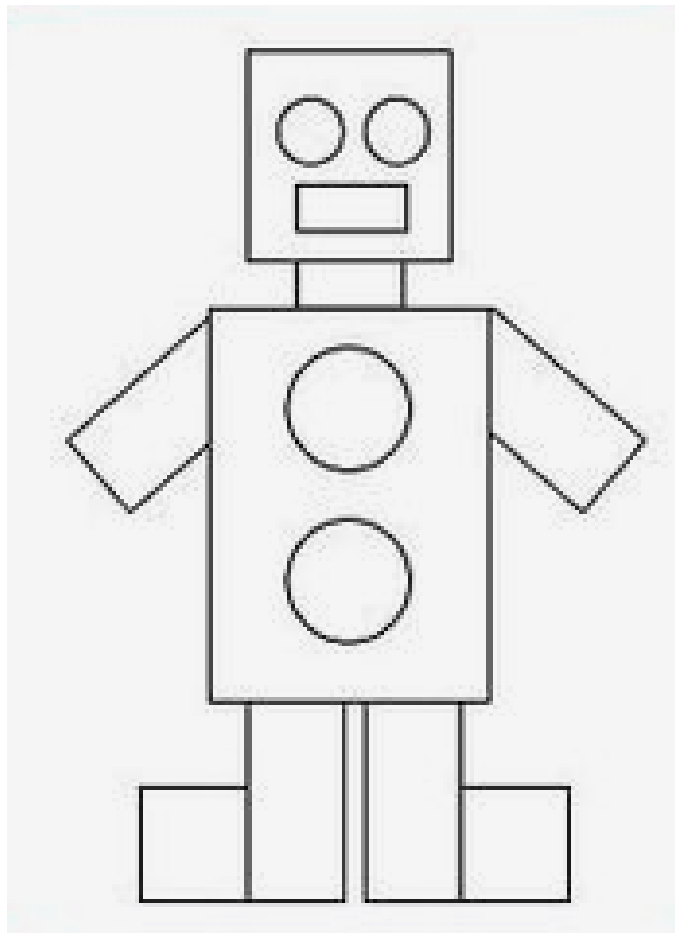
Spring 2 Week 2 Maths task 1 - Horizontal and Vertical

The terms 'horizontal' and 'vertical' can be used to describe properties of shape. If you look at the word 'horizontal', you can see the root word is 'horizon', which means the line where the Earth meets the sky. Knowing this can help you remember that horizontal lines look like **this** ↓



Vertical lines, on the other hand, look like **this** →

Label this picture with H for the horizontal lines and V for the vertical lines.
