Houses - usually wooden huts with thatched straw roofs



Hall - the largest house in the village where the chief lives with his warriors. Also used for feasting.



High fence - all the way around the edge to keep out attackers and wild animals.



Supermarket - for buying food.



Animal enclosures



A village library



Petrol Station - for people to fill up their cars with fuel.



Fields where crops could be grown



Huts for tradespeople - such as potters, carpenters, weavers or blacksmiths.



A clay pit - a source of the clay used for pottery



A river - the main water source for people and animals.



Trees - to use for wood and also to offer natural protection from attackers
