Think about the following to help you:

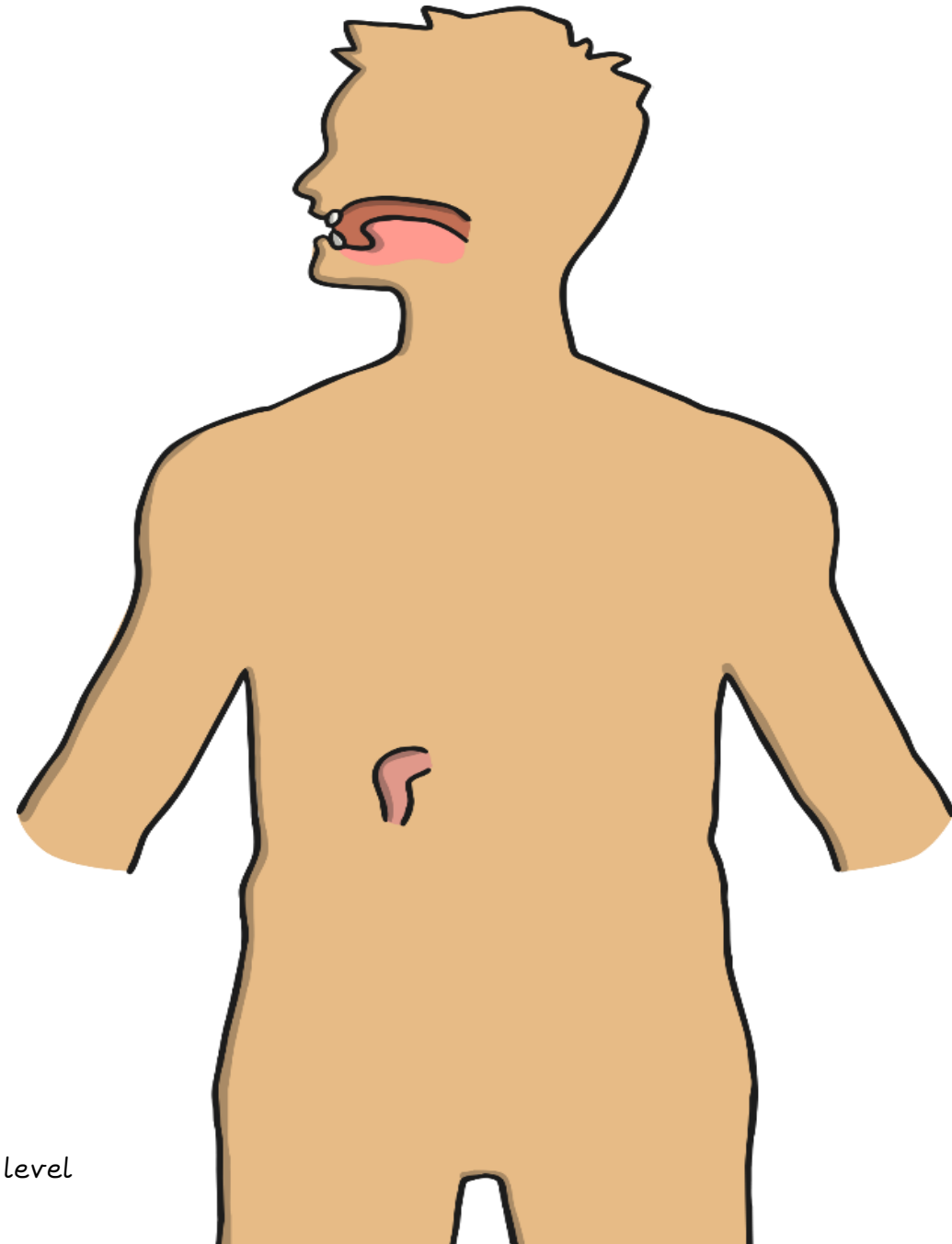
How do humans digest food?

How does food travel through the body?

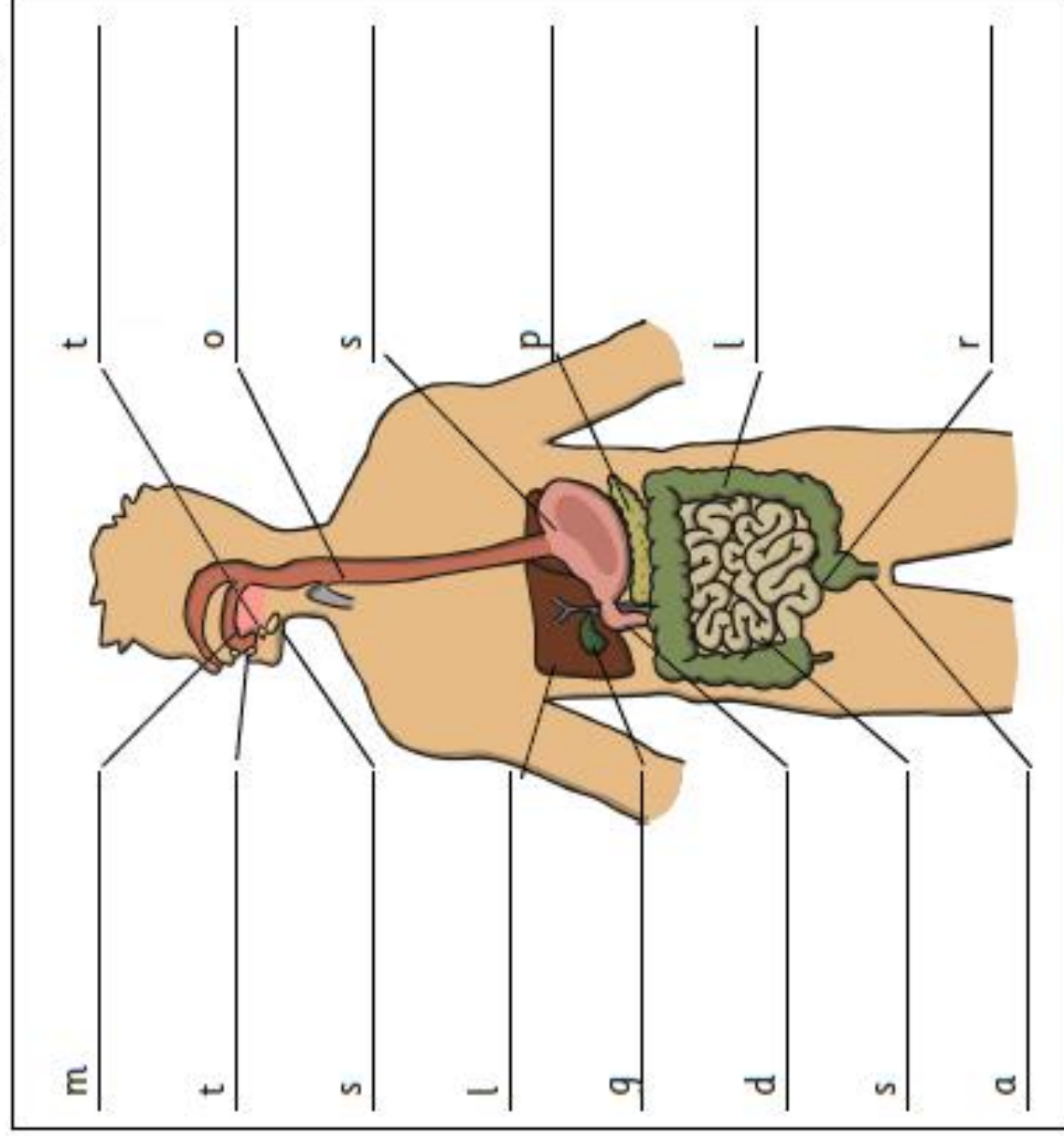
What parts of the body are involved?

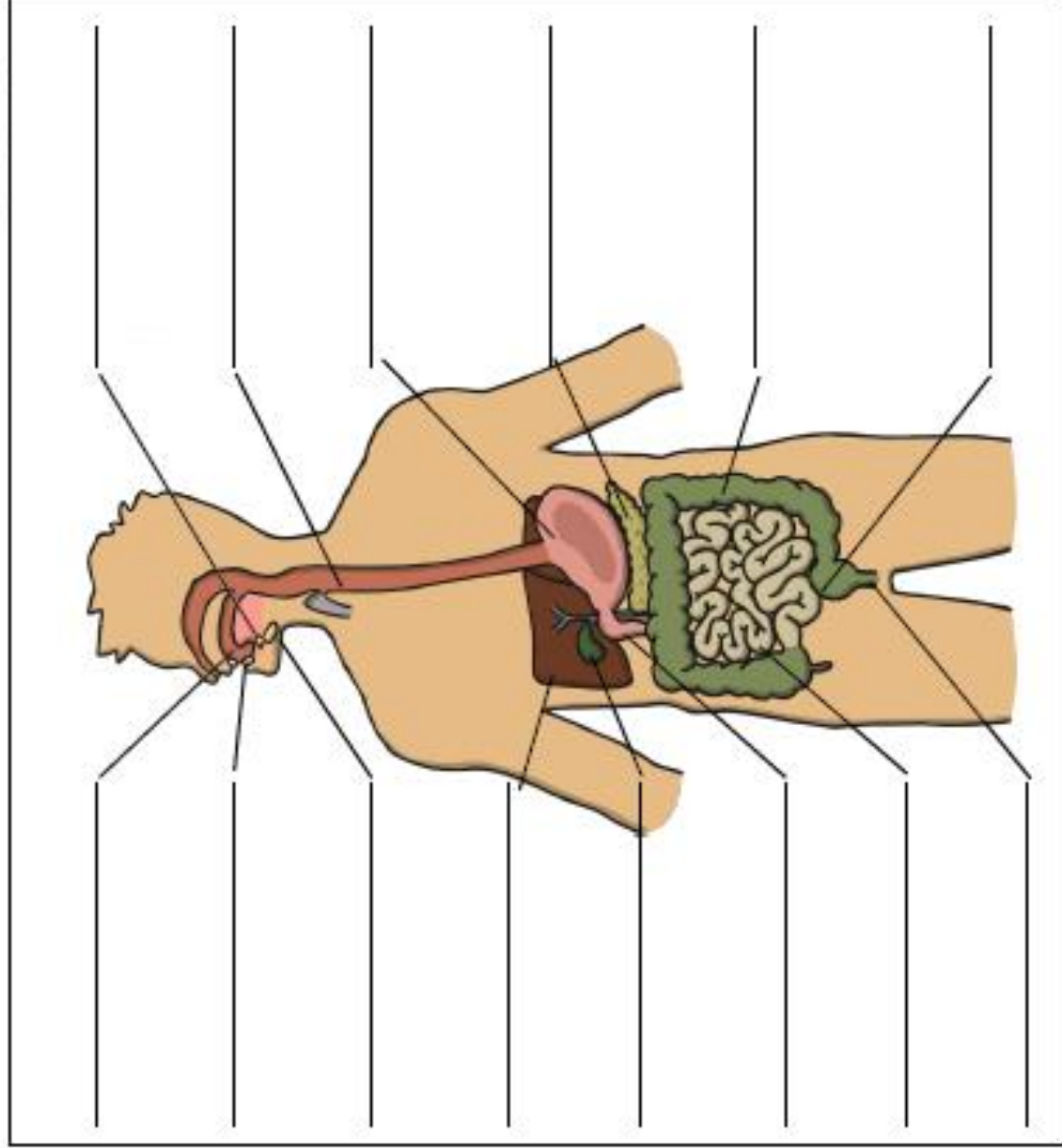

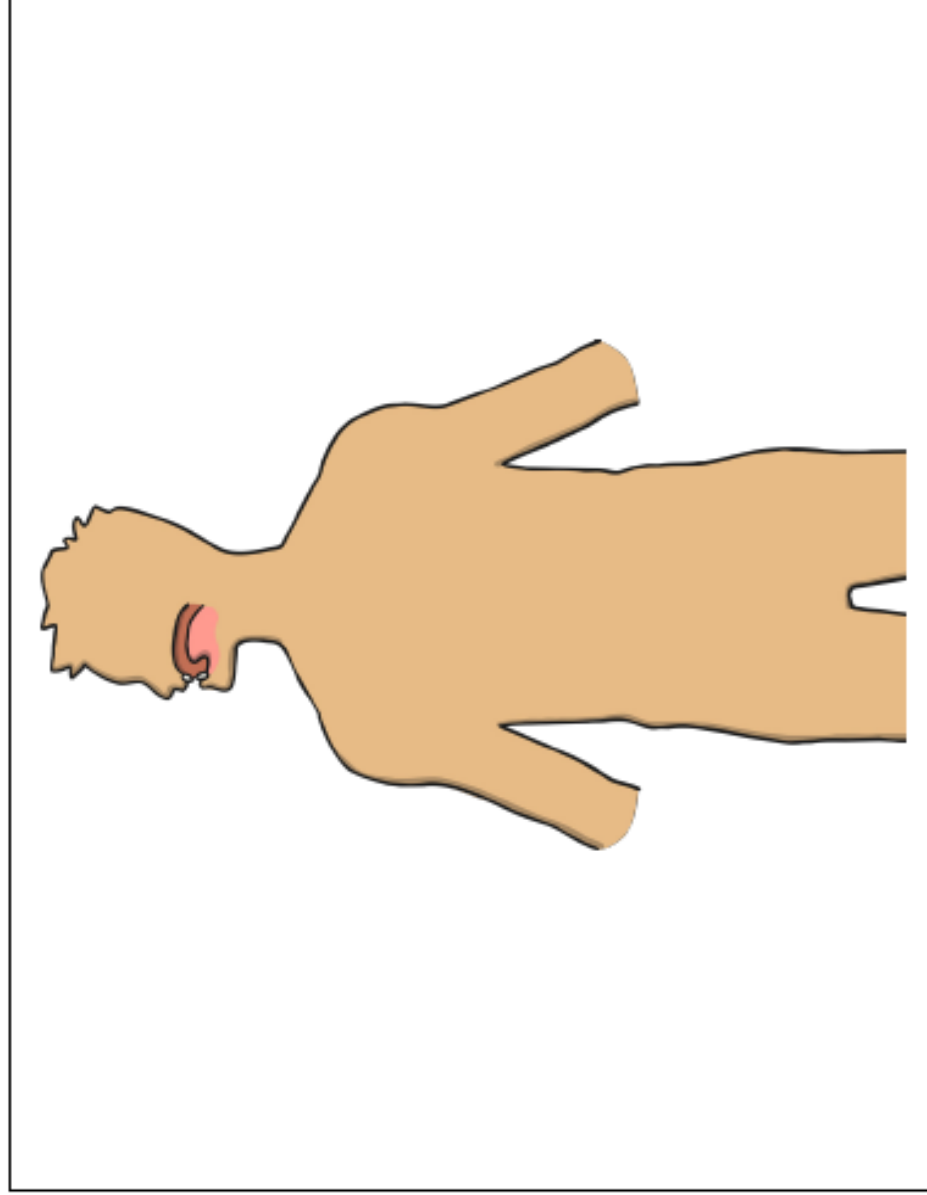
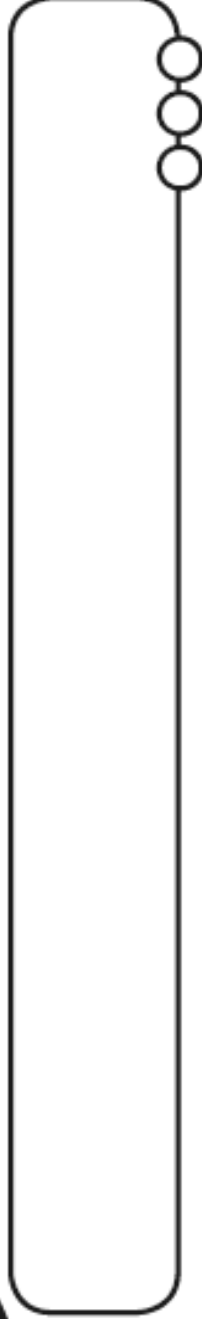
